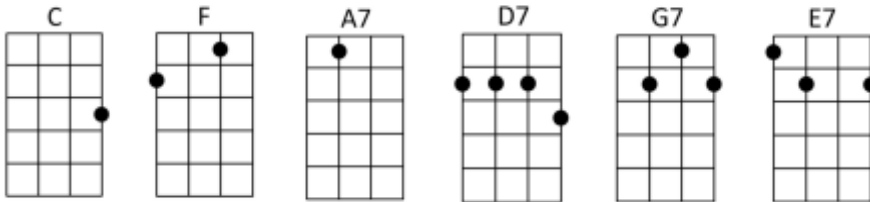




Side By Side by Dean Martin
